### **Water activities for day visitors and holiday makers**

- **Calvert Trust Kielder's** new boathouse at Matthew's Linn offers fully equipped and accessible water activities for people with disabilities, their family and friends, and also day visitors. Individuals, families and groups can choose from instructor-led canoeing, sit-on-top kayaking, sailing and motor cruising to discover parts of Kielder Water that most just can't reach.

- **Leaplish Waterside Park** provides pleasure boats to hire Wednesday to Sunday from Wednesday 21 July to Sunday 5 September 2010 (including bank holiday Monday 30 August), noon to 5pm. Boats are charged at £20 per hour or £12 per half hour (2010 prices). Times may be subject to change and depend on the weather. Rules and regulations also apply.
