Newcastle and Gateshead Waterworks, and other undertakings of which Mr. Nicholson had been engineer. The Blyth and Tyne Railway, originally intended only for the conveyance of coal, was extended by him to Newcastle, Morpeth, Blyth, Nowbiggin, and Tynemouth, and converted into a passenger line. In connection with this enterprise, he also obtained parliamentary power for a line from Gosforth to Stamfordham and Scots Gap, to join the Wansbeck Valley Railway at that time in course of construction. A company having been formed for the purpose of making a railway along the valley of the North Tyne river, he was appointed engineer, prepared the necessary plans for Parliament, and carried out the railway from Hexham to Riccarton Junction. 
